## PROPERTY DETAILS

The units are well-located next to UNC Wilmington with close proximity to retail, food and shopping. While most of the tenants are working professionals, there are a few university students.

All the units have been renovated to include new flooring, stainless steel appliances and painted cabinets with new hardware. Each unit also features a washer and dryer. All units are on their own water meter of which the Tenant pays. The Landlord is responsible for paying the storm water runoff, and the Owner pays the water bill for the mid-term units. Additionally, the Landlord pays for landscaping, dumpster, HVAC filter changes, repairs as needed and a 3rd party property manager (MoveZen) who manages the long-term tenants on the Owner's behalf. The Owner manages the short term tenants in-house.

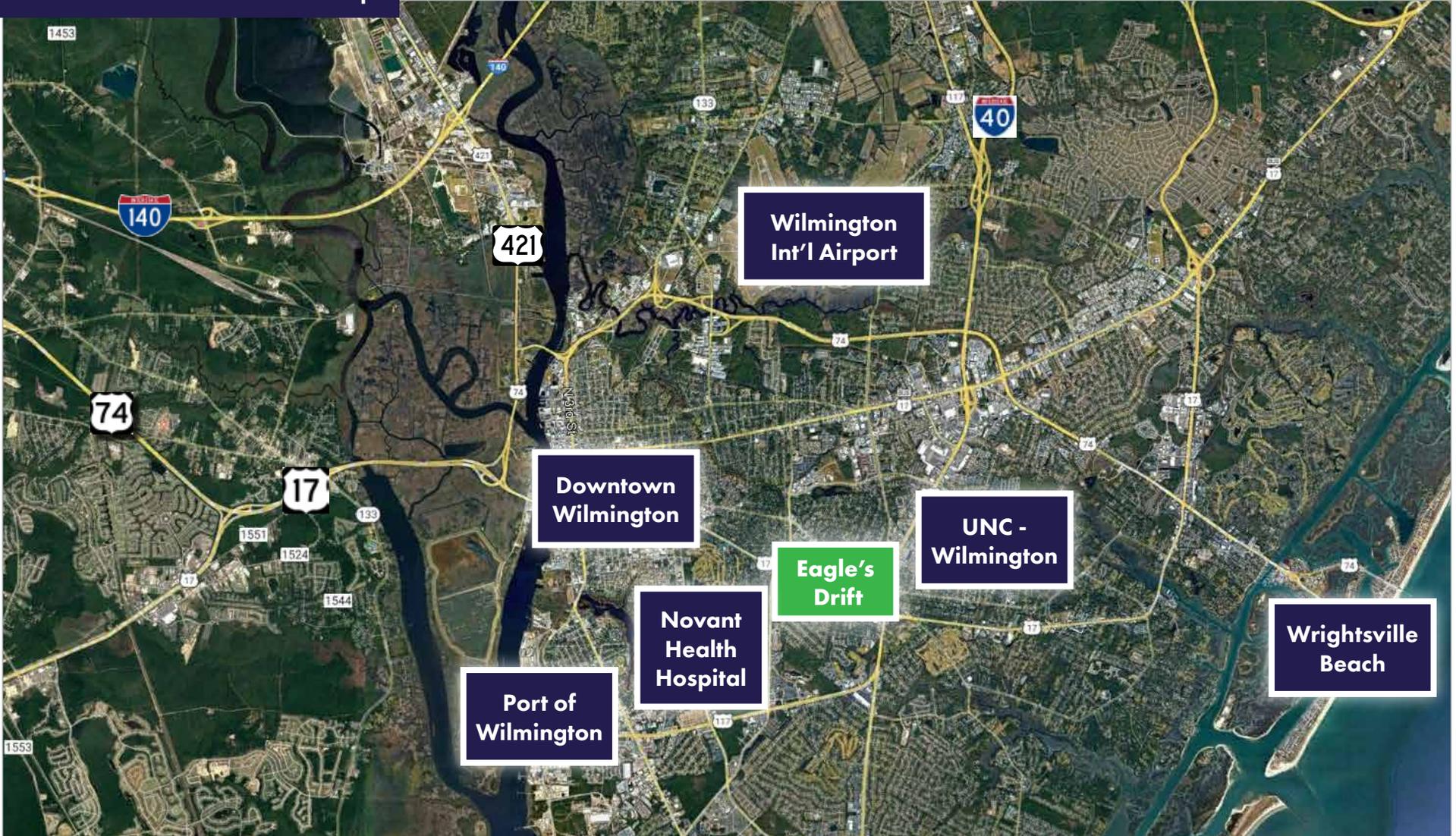

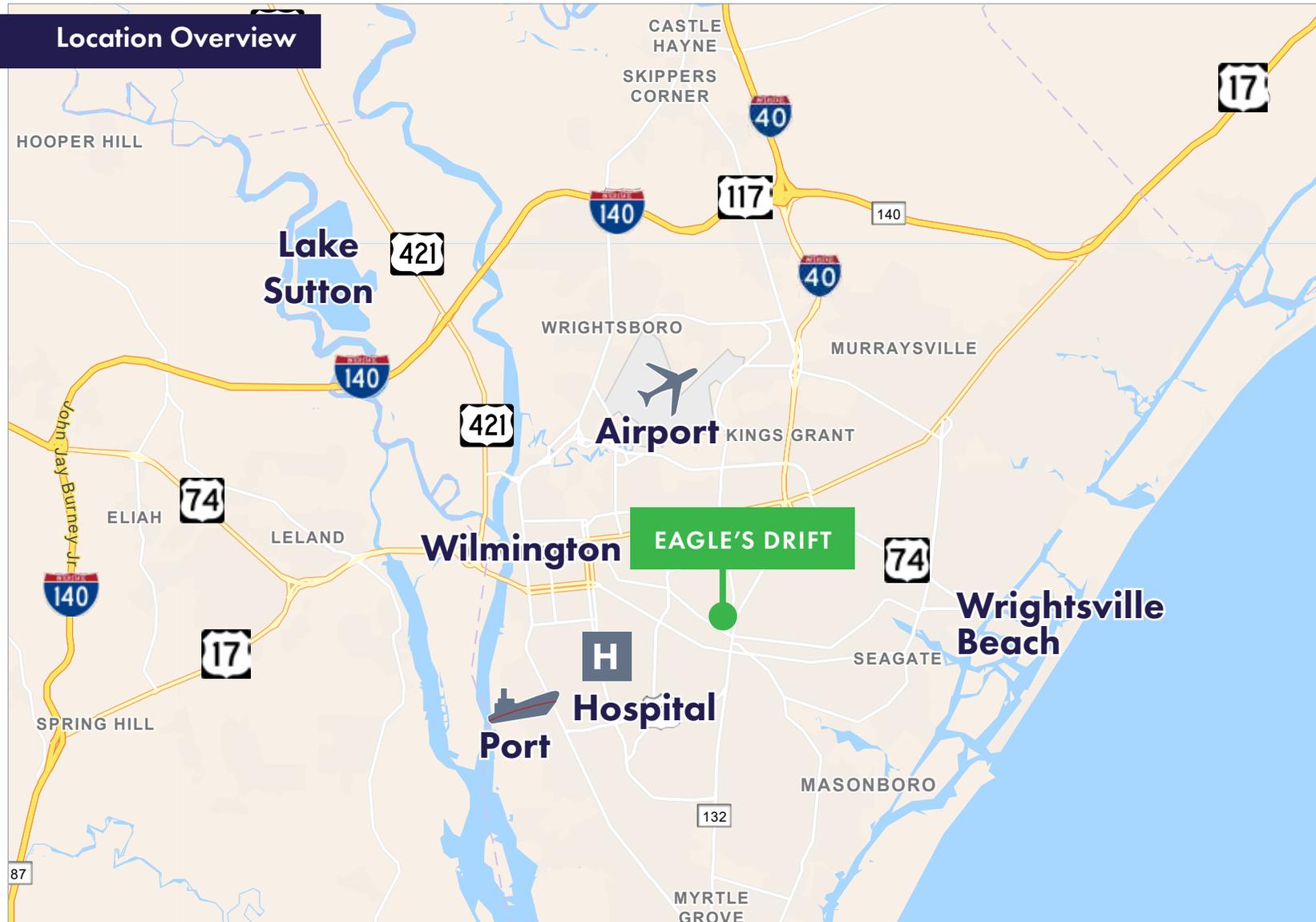
Neighborhood Map



Area Map

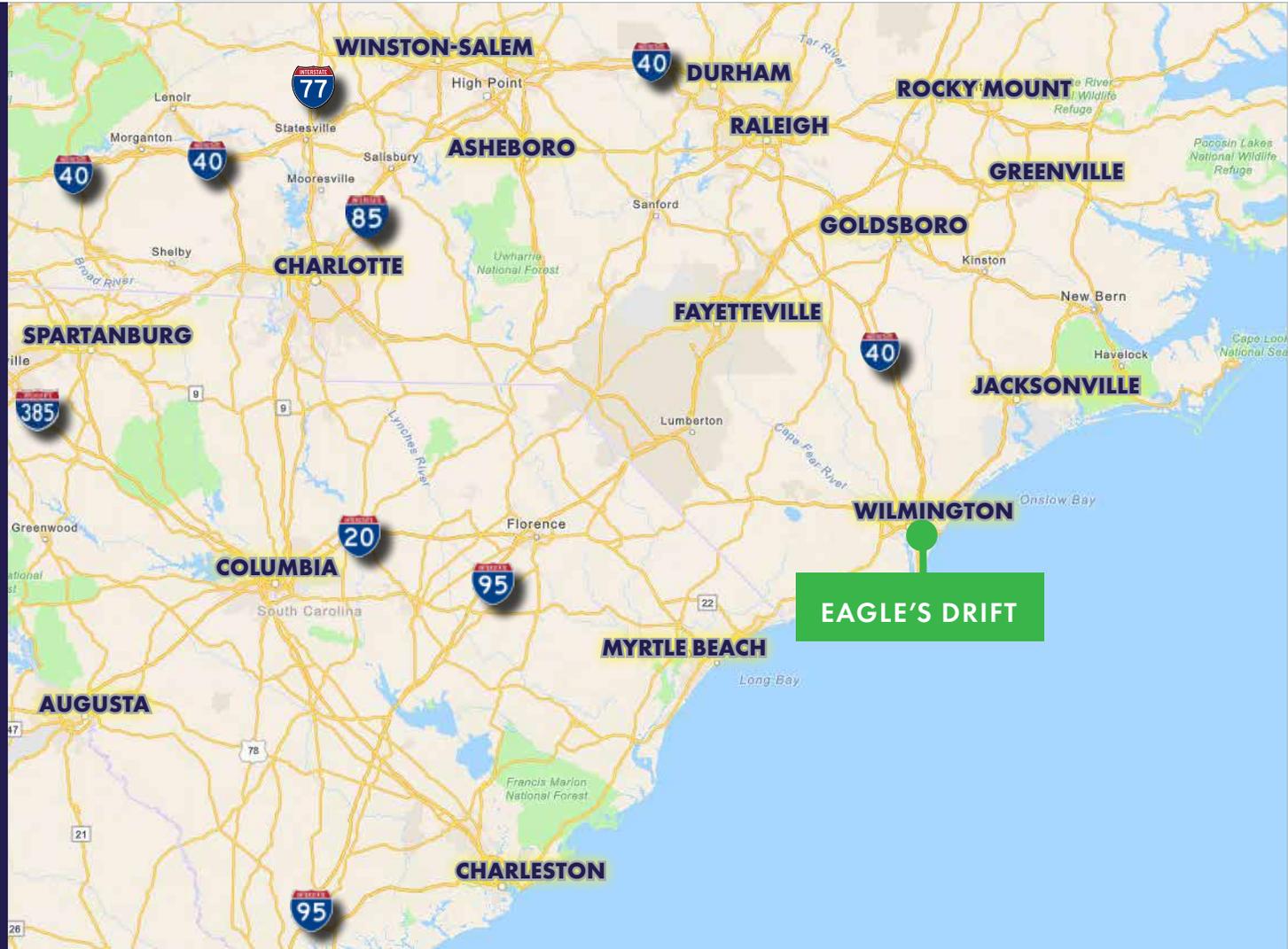


Location Overview
